Interior

The cabin features supple beige leather, offering a refined and comfortable environment for pilot and passengers alike. The six-seat layout is complemented by dual controls, copilot brakes, and multiple storage solutions including a custom floor-mounted box and glareshield glovebox. LED lighting, sunshades for all windows, and headset jacks for all six occupants round out the well-appointed interior.



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Exterior

Finished in an elegant silver with white and blue striping, this A36 features a classic scheme that reflects its heritage without being outdated. Though not the original paint, it remains in excellent condition. The aircraft is always hangared and has been exceptionally well cared for, with three new tires and new alternator installed in 2022.
